ACRL-LA/LUC Meeting - 2001: An Information Odyssey

Mark your calendars!! The annual ACRL-Louisiana/LOUIS Users Conference will be held October 25 and 26, 2001 at Southeastern Louisiana University in Hammond, Louisiana. During its portion of the conference, ACRL/Louisiana will be highlighting information literacy in academic environments. We are happy to announce that the keynote speaker will be Patricia Iannuzzi of the Moffitt Library at the University of California in Berkeley, California. Her talk is entitled "Exploring New Roles for Academic Librarians : The Information Literacy Odyssey" and will take place October 25 to open the conference.

Iannuzzi is well known in instruction circles for her work in integrating information literacy at Florida International University (see <http://www.fiu.edu/~library/ili/index.html>). She is the 2001 recipient of the Miriam Dudley Instruction Librarian Award given by the ACRL Instruction Section. The Dudley Award recognizes an individual librarian who has made an especially significant contribution to the advancement of instruction in a college or research library.

You may have seen her this summer at the ACRL Instruction Section's Annual Conference presenting "Partners in Progress: Using Campus Partnerships to Promote Information Literacy." Slides of her program may be found at <http://www.ala.org/acrl/is/conference/annual01/iannuzzi/sld001.htm>.

We know that she will share some important insights about implementing an information literacy program, and we look forward to seeing you there.


